主任牧師報告 2021

何俊華牧師

作為牧者,昔日在主日崇拜中我可以面向數百位會眾,和大家一起唱詩歌,講道的時候可以留意你們的反應,甚至得到即時回應;散會可以跟你們打個招呼,遇上有需要的弟兄姊妹,可以即時和你們一起祈禱。

現在我甚至連誰是會眾也不知道,唱詩讚美的時間多數會用心靈和應,或者輕聲唱出來,但卻聽不到其他會眾的歌聲;講道也是比較單向的;散會的時候也遇不見會眾的蹤影。 相信沒有人會意料得到,新冠肺炎疫情會在 2021 年繼續蔓延,大致上,教會生活跟 2020 年 3 月之後沒有多大的不同之處,唯一的分別可算是於 2021 年秋季,教會能夠有幾個月的實體崇拜聚會,這也是神的恩典,給盼望實體聚會的弟兄姊妹有一個回味體驗群體敬拜的機會,讓我們可以走在一起在教堂的建築物內敬拜。

當我反思在疫情下的信仰和牧會生活,多少覺得這是神給基督徒的考驗甚至熬煉,是一個檢討自己有否與神同行,除去屬靈雜質的時機。若果我們在疫情前有專心敬拜神,在疫情當中又有否專心敬拜神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好問問自己一直有否跟神建立密切的關係。若果我們在疫情前有忠心事奉神,在疫情當中又有否忠心事奉神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好反省自己事奉神的動機何在。若果我們在疫情前有努力見證神,在疫情當中又有否努力見證神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好回想自己昔日是如何認識主,讓見證神的心再一次被挑旺起來。若果我們在疫情前有以生命榮耀神,在疫情當中又有否以生命榮耀神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好檢討自己的品格,繼續在地上反映神的形象。若果我們在疫情前有追求認識神,在疫情當中又有否追求認識神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好把握機會學習神的話語,並且親身地經歷神的同在。若果我們在疫情前有犧牲地以金錢尊榮神,在疫情當中又有否犧牲地以金錢尊榮神?若果答案是「沒有」,便要好好思想神給你的恩典,以財物支持神家的工作。

當上主在基遍向所羅門第一次顯現,容許王向自己發出懇求,所羅門明白自己只是神的僕人,所以他所求的是智慧,即是能夠判斷百姓和辨別是非的能力 (列王紀上三 5-9),讓作為神子民的以色列,能夠在地上成就神的計劃。 盼望我們教會的領袖無論在任何日子,同樣能夠明白自己只是神的僕人,責任是帶領會眾行在神的心意當中;同時盼望我們教會的弟兄姊妹無論在任何日子,同樣能夠明白自己有神的子民這個尊貴的身份,繼續在地上完成神給我們的託付。

新冠肺炎名為 COVID-19 (Coronavirus Disease 2019),以開始的年份作為標記,每天看到的新聞頭條也是關於疫情,盼望在 2022 年,我們生命的主題並不是新冠肺炎,而是神自己,是耶穌基督的福音。

Senior Pastor Report 2021

As a pastor, I used to be able to see hundreds of congregants and sing with them together during Sunday service. I could see your responses, even your immediate responses while preaching. I could greet you after service, and pray for your specific needs right on the spot.

Now I don't even know who is in the congregation. Most of the time during singspiration, I sing in my heart or hum softly, but I can't hear the congregation sing. Preaching has become one-directional. When the service ends, I am unable to meet with anyone in the congregation. None of us had expected that the pandemic would last beyond 2021. Generally speaking, our church life has remained in status quo since March, 2020. The only exception is that in the fall of 2021, we were able to gather together physically for a few months. It was by God's grace that we were allowed to have brothers and sisters worshipping physically as a community in our church building again. Many have been looking forward to it.

When I reflect on my faith and pastoral life under the pandemic, I feel that this was God's test, or refinement process for us as Christians. It is a time for us to review if we have been walking with God, and to remove any spiritual impurities in ourselves. If we were dedicated to worship God before the pandemic, are we still dedicated to worshipping God during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we should ask ourselves whether or not we have built a close relationship with God. If we served God faithfully before the pandemic, are we still serving Him faithfully during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we need to reflect on our motivation for serving God. If we worked hard to be God's witness before the pandemic, are we still working hard to be a witness during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we must carefully recall how we came to the LORD in the past so as to revive our passion for testifying about Him. If we glorified God with our lives before the pandemic, are we still glorifying God with our lives during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we must examine our character and continue to manifest God's image on earth. If we sought to know God before the pandemic, are we still seeking to know Him during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we must seize the opportunity to learn God's words and experience his presence. If we sacrificially honoured God with our giving before the pandemic, are we still sacrificially honouring God with our giving during the pandemic? If the answer is "no", we should consider God's grace and give generously to God's work.

When the LORD appeared to Solomon for the first time at Gibeon, he allowed the king to make a request. Solomon understood that he was only God's servant, so what he asked for was wisdom, a discerning heart to govern the people and to distinguish between right and wrong (1 Kings 3:5-9), so that Israel, God's people, could fulfill God's plan on earth.

I hope that the leaders of our church would, regardless of the circumstances we are in, understand that we are only God's servants. Our responsibility is to lead the congregation to walk in God's will. At the same time, I hope that brothers and sisters in our church would, no matter what circumstances we are in, realize that we have a royal identity as God's people. We need to press on and fulfill what God has entrusted to us here on earth.

COVID-19, (Coronavirus 2019), was so named because it began in the year 2019. Since then, news headlines we have seen everyday are all about the pandemic. My hope is that in 2022, the theme of our lives will no longer be about COVID-19, but God Himself and the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Continued Facing Challenges with COVID-19

We continue to face unforeseen challenges due to COVID-19. As the number of daily cases reduced in the summer, BPD and Council approved to gradually reopen the church in August for hybrid online and physical gatherings in Sunday Service, Sunday School, and Cell group meetings, as recommended by the Reopen Committee. However, in December, due to the rapid spread of COVID-19 Omicron variant, we had to stop all physical gatherings in MCBC again and immediately switched to online gatherings for Sunday Service, Sunday School, and Cell group meetings. We are thankful for the support from our Pastoral and Office Staff, and volunteers, who are willing to serve in creative ways online in various ministries during these uncertain pandemic situations.

MCBC Community Concern Committee

With the launch of the Community Concern Committee, we have encouraged our congregations in all Divisions to donate food/clothing and raise funds via walkathon to local charitable organizations, such as Urban Promise. Our congregations are willing to help our local communities, who suffer from this economic downturn due to the pandemic.

Influx of Hong Kong New Immigrants

Our Cantonese Division is developing a plan with Pastors and volunteers to assist new immigrants from Hong Kong, who are looking for joining a church and settle down in Toronto. We will continue to adjust our plan to meet the needs of these new immigrants who want to join MCBC.

We are grateful to have Simon Ng joined us as English Division Worship Director this year.

Church Council Report

Looking back on 2021, the repeated outbreak of the new coronavirus continued to ravage the world. We are thankful for God's protection, keeping us safely through, and for His using us, so that we were able to continue working on our mission as Christians in this tough environment.

The door of the gospel has not been closed even though everyone needs to stay home; on the contrary, new areas have been opened up online, breaking through locational limitations. Through online Alpha Course, online seminars for missions/outreach ministry, open evangelistic activities in shopping malls, online evangelistic meetings, virtual evangelistic meetings by our short-term mission teams and the New Immigrants Ministry, we were able to reach out to people in local community as well as overseas. In summer, when the pandemic situation improved, we made some improvements in the safety to our church facilities which enabled us to gradually reopen in August with hybrid online and physical gatherings. Everyone could choose the way they felt comfortable to participate in worship service and other gatherings.

At the end of 2021, Rev. Edward Leung retired. We thank him for his many years of faithful service, shepherding and leadership. While we are reluctant to let him go, we are glad that he was able to return to Hong Kong and reunite with his wife.

一個微小的病毒,引致全球的恐慌,一切活動都停頓下來;教會都不會例外,自 2020 年三月十五日起,麥浸暫停早午堂的實體主日崇拜及一切活動,改在網上進行。臺下的事奉崗位,包括諮詢、迎賓、司事都不用參與。臺上的事奉也需要全面轉型,配合網上崇拜。嘩!想不到竟跨越至 2021年的八月中旬。

自從轉到網上崇拜,撇開需要隔空練習、各自錄音、後期製作等等技術上的困難,最大的挑戰,其實是如何保持崇拜的群體意識和會眾的參與度。主日崇拜的本意是我們作為一個群體,同心敬拜神。無奈,當我們實際上處於不同的空間,身邊只有家人,甚至是獨自一人的時候,很容易就會將崇拜個人化。在這樣的環境底下,到底如何才能夠有效地帶領會眾體驗群體敬拜,不讓崇拜失味呢?有見及此,我們於八月二十一日舉辦了《崇拜的意義》網上講座,邀請吉中鳴牧師分享信息,並為事奉團隊提供一些音樂事奉上的培訓。然而,一劑「強心針」是否就能夠解決問題呢?誠然不能。求神幫助我們,在各種限制底下,依然能夠同心作為一個屬靈群體,專心地敬拜祂。

感謝神!疫情於夏天有所緩解,教會決定八月十五日先重啟午堂的實體崇拜,早堂仍是採用錄影模式。雖然實體崇拜有著不同的防疫限制,但也總算是一個回歸「正常」的開始。久久沒有踏足教會建築物的弟兄姊妹們,終於可以再次回到禮拜堂一起崇拜。讀經和帶領祈禱的弟兄姊妹也恢復參與事奉。敬拜小組無需再隔空練習、預先錄影,可以面對面配搭,釋除了不少壓力。詩班雖未能恢復實體練習和獻詩,但依然堅持透過錄影的方式,忠心事奉。而停止了一年多臺下事奉的崗位,又該如何去重組呢?幸好過去的日子,我們都會透過網上,每月第一個星期五晚見面,分享弟兄姐妹面對不同的困難,彼此代禱。新的配搭、新的組合,無人能憑經驗說應該怎樣作,祇有在實踐中去模索。最初每星期都有更新、改動,不容易適應。傳遞改變,靠着信心,愛心擺上,求主引領!

這一年多以來,我們輾轉經歷了多種不同的崇拜模式:由全面於網上舉行,到實體加上同步直播,到現在變種病毒來襲,又回到網上的錄播模式。為配合這些變更,影音團隊承擔著巨大的壓力,付出了相當多的努力。疫情迫使我們嘗試以前不常接觸的科技,雖然不容易也會碰釘,但這都是一個美好的學習過程。縱然我們是在「迫於無奈」的情況下嘗試新科技,但相信所得來的知識不是枉然的。盼望這一切累積下來的經驗,能幫助教會在瞬息萬變的時代中發展。於十二月五日與新媒體事

工合作的現場製作《龍門陣》就是一個嶄新嘗試的好例子。透過牧者的對話、詩歌的回應、弟兄姐 妹實體和網上的參與,一同感恩,事就成了!

小組牧養平台

2021 年繼續在新冠疫情中渡過,雖然小組依然保留網上聚會的平台,但也在疫情回落期間有不同實體小組聚會。多謝主的恩典,叫弟兄姊妹有機會「面對面」的相聚,又叫我們思想將來在神的國裏,我們能夠與主「面對面」的時候,將會是何等大的恩典和喜樂!另外,也感謝 Zoom Support Team 的事奉團隊,當中的弟兄姊妹都不遺餘力,幫忙在小組聚會和其他聚會上的支援,讓弟兄姊妹可以保持連繫。

小組牧養平台繼續乗持教會的方向:「齊心承傳福音,銳意建立門徒」,於小組查經上,2021 年採用證主書室所出版的 「3D 研經系列:普通書信」,給予小組有更豐富的資料去準備。另外,小組牧養平台嘗試推行「牧區」(Zone) 模式的小組牧養。在初步嘗試下,把不同相近背景和人生階段的小組都招聚在同一個牧區之下,由幾位不同導師一同牧養帶領,盼望能夠帶出更加適切不同小組需要的關顧和牧養。在四月和十月期間有不同牧區的聚會:四月份有黃明方牧師的 「疫情中的夫婦關係」和 陳國雄博士的「領導力與創意思維」;十月份以「男女大不同」為總主題,有 Zone A/B 的「圓滿繽紛的人生」(講員:林志輝牧師 和 羅乃萱師母)以及 Zone C/D 的「轉角有出路」(講員:郭展能傳道 和 方潘美玲傳道)。除此以外,不同牧區的導師和小組組長又有不同模式的小組 huddle,讓不同牧區的導師和小組之間可以有更靈活的方式去牧養和引導。

另外,2021年3-5月期間,也舉辦了針對小組組長和核心組員的訓練:「靈巧好牧人」。除了有新舊組長和核心組員參與之外,更有許多小組導師當中協助帶領,讓參與者在三個月的緊密同行之下,互相勉勵和成長。加上六月舉辦的「小組組長加油站/差遣禮」,由梁廷益牧師分享有關大使命和小組的關係,鼓勵小組組長要讓耶穌基督的大使命成為小組牧養的目標和方向。

面對日益增加的香港回流人士與新移民,小組牧養平台有與教會其他各部門一同合作,參與新移民 平台的服侍,並在當中設立團契「新移民天地」,讓新移民與教會有更多接軌和認識的機會,盼望 能夠幫助他們找到合適的小組參與,建立穩定的教會生活,一同成長。

最後,2021年也有許多人事上的變動。梁炳剛牧師完成在麥浸多年來事奉,在年底正式宣佈引退。 另外,夏敏聰執事也完成執事的任期,也從導師團隊中退出,我們感謝主在過去賜予我們兩位忠心 的僕人,謹守崗位,讓許多小組一直以來得着造就和幫助。求主繼續賜福和帶領他們前面的路程。

外展事工

自從去年新冠肺炎疫情爆發之後,疫情一直起伏不斷,今年外展事工的服事以「新常態」下作事工 佈署與調配。發展網上平台以作為服事的向度與及接觸點來推動佈道、栽培事奉。

我們在三月到四月份期間舉辦了二個系列的抗疫新常態「自有良方」網上專題講座,二月底至三月底第一個系列「調節失衡、舒緩壓力及改善痛症運動學習」的三堂講座平均人數為 90 人,藉此接觸到當中約三分之一的非基督徒朋友,而每次講座中段皆備有福音信息與及分組認識時間。而第二個專題系列是「明辨細思疫情大流行趨勢」參加講座人數超過 100 人,同樣當中非基督徒比率約三分之一。

而順着從專題講座的延伸效應,我們在四月至五月期間的週六早上時段,開辦第二屆「網上啟發課程」(On Line Alpha Course),除了邀請經專題講座接觸得到的朋友們外,也透過會眾去邀請朋友與親友參加,藉着網絡能開放時間與地域界限,增加更多參與的空間。在這二個月的緊凑課程裡,各學員得以在輕鬆與誠摯的氛圍下,以開放的心去追求認識基督信仰,在聖靈的引領下福音信息得以散播在參加者心裡,而不同小組的參加者在課程後推介到其他福音班別,當中仍會透過「小組查經」形式繼續追求認識基督信仰。

而今年「三福得人漁夫」佈道訓練在主日學時段開辦了二次課程,因疫情原故課程改在網絡平台上 授課,並且部份課程要求則配合疫情現況作靈活調配。三月至五月季度「三福佈道訓練 (非証書)」共有二名學員完成訓練,而在九月至十一月的季度同樣有二名學員順利完成課程。

而今年所參與的新春佈道、復活節「疫境恩情 - 復活節視像慶祝節目匯演」、「第八屆耶穌愛華埠」及聖誕節「希望、仁愛與和平」慶祝聖誕 - 佈道雙動能週」等的本地佈道,在疫情時明時暗的情况下,大多採用靈活的視象電話佈道與實體佈道形式進行,為不同地區的朋友、親友與及商戶們在疫情長期困擾下,帶來福音與鼓勵信息。今年及至聖誕節期間,在疫情稍為穩定下,我們得以參與短宣中心聖誕節廣場佈道,並在教會鄰近「王府井商場」参與福音遊戲攤位佈道及在鄰近社區裡報佳音並進行探訪佈道。

在今年新常態的形勢下,過往持續的部份事工,如孟嘗護理院長者探訪等都因着在疫情下長者安全原故,仍然需要暫停去為住院的長者們帶來探望、敬拜與分享福音信息的服事。至於佈道會聚會方面,經檢視在新常態的疫情日子下,或許需達至網絡與實體的「雙軌制」的出現,才會帶來預期果效,故仍正等待合適時機來重拾此類形服事。

栽培事工

主席:李伯泓執事

自去年疫情爆發後,教會栽培事工的主日學課程皆轉向網上平台授課,同時也因應情况正佈署試用 在線與實體課室並行的「雙軌形式」授課,以作為在新常態下的推進方向。

而今年在主日學專題講座方面,今年八月份暑期專題講座共有二個講座,八月初先有由周漢桑牧師主講:「回到猶太根源」講座系列,參加者對課題回應熱烈。接着在八月底則由漢語網絡神學院提

供劉永明博士主講「兩極之間:耶穌基督所展示的基督教」講座。八月份總數五堂網上專題講座為 我們帶來寶貴學習與屬靈亮光,網上平均参與人數皆接近 100 人。

而十二月期間我們再次邀請到周漢桑牧師主領一連三週的「回到猶太根源 II 」系列講座,專題講座環繞猶太人眼中的釋經、 彌赛亞與神的國度這三個主題,平均參加人數維持約90人。

至於不同季度網上主日學報讀情況,因着會眾漸漸適應轉用網上平台的原故,全年的平均報讀人數,比較去年疫情剛爆發期間皆有所回升,以網上崇拜人數為基數,上半年每季報讀人數大約為35-40%之間,而下半年每季報讀人數大約為40-45%之間,這與2020年疫情開始時相比,2021年第四季度主日學出勤率穩步回升。

今年因應推動事奉人員在網絡與媒體事工上的學習,我們為參加漢語網絡神學院主辦《教會媒體事工實踐系列課程》的事奉人員提供註冊費半數資助,藉以鼓勵更多事奉人員投身参與新發展的服事。

而我們與中國神學研究院協辦的「生命之道」查經課程,自去年三月份的季度在疫情爆發之後停止實體課堂以後,我們在每季度都會再三評估在疫情不斷轉化下所存在的擴散風險來作復課决定,故此今年所有季度也困疫情未能平復而繼續被迫停開實體課堂。栽培事工鼓勵會眾在新常態下,繼續透過網絡註冊來持續参與「生命之道」查經課程。與此同時,把握與善用網上多種類資源去栽培在主裡追求更新成長。

新媒體事工作策劃 聯同 數個協助事工單位合辦節目。首次作每週 Live YouTube 宣傳 。配合 WhatsApp, YouTube, Zoom 作即時觀眾留言參與其中。

新移民服侍

「加門為你開 」新移民服事平台

在過去的一段時間,因着香港處境上種種的不同變化下,不少以廣東話為母語的家庭,在短期內移民或回流加拿大,亦有不少以工作簽証及留學生身份前來多倫多區。

同期麥浸的一些小組經已開始接待一些移民來的家庭及留學生,並且數目持續增長。另一方面也收 到會友關心教會如何服事新移民的查詢與及參與服事新移民的建議。

而在此等動向下,「教牧執事會」委派同工去籌建服事平台來回應當下的情况,以教會為本位的服事方向來接待移民或回流家庭、人任們,讓他們能夠適應新生活,再次融入教會生活,建立屬靈群體身份,亦期待透過此平台邀請到未信主移民朋友前來参加。

而「加門為你開」新移民服事平台以三個向度來建立此服事:

- 1. 提供一般移民的生活資訊,例如,住居、教育、工作等類,協助適應多倫多的新生活。
- 2. 分享自身的移民經驗來鼓勵新移民朋友,建立同行者的聯係與適切支持。
- 3. 為在移民路上或其間所經歷的掙扎、壓力或所引發的情緒,提供以基督信仰為核心的心靈及靈性牧養。

現時的服事團隊是以外展、小組、關顧部教牧與及一位委任執事為主力帶領,並加上多位核心成員 以委員會形式來推動各項服事,在委員會之下設有各個服事部份,並都經已建立團隊來推動其工 作。

在服事内容方面,首先在今年7月開始以「網上講座」形式來提供在多倫多「衣食住行」移民生活 資訊,全年共主辦了6次講座,平均有50個家庭參與講座。並藉此去建立接觸點,來引帶至其他 服事部份。

而在今年 9 月中旬,「加門為你開」在教會不同事工部門與小組的協助下,在教會露天停車場舉辦首次「迎新會」來歡迎新到埗的移民朋友,在熱鬧氣氛下,教會得以與眾人彼此認識,建立更進一步的關係。整個聚會接近 100 人參與。

而去到在 10 月中,亦開始建立「新移民天地」以團契形式來接待經已到埗的家庭及人仕,讓新朋友們在新環境中可以得着交流心聲,彼此鼓勵,築建屬靈關係,並得以融入麥浸屬靈之家。聚會人數亦由開始時的 10 多位朋友,漸漸上升至 20 多位朋友。然而因疫情原故,原先的實體聚會需要轉為網上聚會。

現時「加門為你開」的服事正為配合新移民朋友們不同人生階段及身份的需要,來開展新一輪服事,願主感召更多會眾來參與服事,並賜恩予不同服事團隊得着關懷的心與靈屬恩賜。

English Division Ministry Report

English Ministry Team

What started off as a year hoping we would soon be able to return to some normalcy has been a year of perseverance? Another year of lockdown. Another year of virtual fellowship.

This year perhaps has been even more challenging than 2020 as the toll of everything virtual is starting to take its toll. However, in our weakness, God is still very much present and working. Our worship service has evolved from recorded online worship to streaming live worship. Our small groups continue to be filled with people eager to study God's word. And as we closed 2021, we even had a short taste of in-person worship! Praise God for all that he has done and is continuing to do when we are overburdened, burnt out and at our limits.

As we begin another year with yet another wave of lockdowns, there is hope and "light at the end of the tunnel". A reminder that God is our hope. He will carry us through and He will continue to bless the ministries we are faithful to.

May you be blessed, filled, and renewed this year as we continue to glorify Him.

But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. (Isaiah 40: 31)

Worship Ministry

For the English Ministry worship ministry, this year was as tough on us as it was on any other. However, God has been faithful in His provision. In May of 2021, we hired our first ever Worship Director, Simon Ng. During his first few months of service, he worked on increasing the quality of worship services, focusing on making the service feel as close to an in-person experience as possible, first with the Zoom services, and then with the hybrid services on YouTube. This process involved training the A/V team on an entirely new system to facilitate live streaming the in-person services, re-establishing synergy between the AV and worship teams, as well as within each team, and helping Pastor Freddy with coordinating the service, and communicating visions and directions.

God has also demonstrated His goodness in that even during the lockdown, our worship and AV teams have been serving tirelessly and faithfully. Our team numbers have not only maintained, but grew by a few members, during the pandemic. Simon and Sam, the Director and Chair, respectively, have worked together to care for our team and set them up for success, and they are eager to continue to do even more so for 2022.

Small Groups Ministry

The Covid-19 pandemic continued in 2021. Several groups did have chances to have outdoor gatherings for hiking and playing sports in the summer. Some family groups met in "family clusters" to join the Zoom meetings so pairs of families could connect in-person while connecting online with the larger group. Several young adult groups resumed in-person SG meetings in MCBC from September to December but went back to online meetings due to Covid Delta situation.

SG huddles were held each time there was a 5th Sunday of the month. SG leaders met together on Zoom to share updates from their groups, cross pollinate ideas, and to pray for each other.

One of the major tasks in the small groups ministry is to successfully complete the SG training part 1 (i.e. for all SG members). The training includes a training video, curriculum document and questionnaire.

- The training video covered the vision of MCBC SG ministry, the theology of SG, Jesus' approach to discipleship, the core elements of a healthy small group, the timeline and structure of SG ministry, and the roles in a SG. The training video is uploaded on the MCBC YouTube channel and linked to the MCBC website for all SG members to access.
- The curriculum document is a transcript of the training video as a resource for reference.
- The questionnaire is a Google form with questions designed to test comprehension of the training's content. After a member completes the video training, they complete the Google form and their SG leader reviews their answers.

All small groups have completed the training video with the existing small group members. Moving forward, any newly joined SG members have to go through the same training materials before they join the small group. This will make sure that all SG members have the same understanding of SG core values and how MCBC SG ministry works. The training video has been posted on the MCBC website for those who may be interested in coming to MCBC.

The next milestone will be the part 2 training which is for SG leaders and potential leaders. The plan is to have this part 2 training start in June 2022. This training is designed to equip leaders of all demographics with the knowledge, skills, and mindset to serve in the SG ministry.

Nurturing Ministry

Sunday School continues to be affected by the prolong COVID pandemic, and we were only able to conclude one course from 2020, Rise of Israel's Monarchy looking at 2 Samuel, and offer one topical course for a prolong period of time from May to December, Christian and Society. Attendance has been steady between 7 to 12 students. COVID fatigue has worn out many people to want to stay on further to watch more online. Our hope is we can have classes in the church building and rebuild the base again.

Caring Ministry

Throughout 2021, with ongoing public health guideline changes regarding in person gatherings, it was difficult to regularly connect and care for our brothers and sisters. For those who were not connected to a small group, we reached out with phone calls to stay in touch, including offering prayer support. For those in small groups, we created caring packages which included a customized mug to encourage and help everyone remember God's love for them, and our church community's bonds to lift each other up. Our hope and eager prayer is to meet in person once again.

2022 Outlook

By the time you read this annual report, we will have lived through 2 years of varying degrees of pandemic life. Much of our 2021 ministry plans, aspirations and hopes to deliver in-person ministry opportunities were postponed or cancelled altogether. And yet, God equipped us to carry through this period. In many ways we also thrived despite the lockdowns and restrictions. We brought on more full-time and part-time

staff, bolstered our YLD and Children ministries, hired our first-ever English worship director and so much more. Brothers and sisters of all generations came together to keep worship ministry, small groups, overseas and local missions, finance, HR, Sunday school running. In so many ways, God used us to reach more souls in ways we've never had to before. God stretched us. Our minds. Our hearts. Our idea of what ministry ought to look like.

And so when we now look forward to the year ahead, I'm supremely confident that no matter what comes our way, God has and will equip us in our time of need. 2022 is trending to be the year of recovery. From the obvious damage COVID brought to our community. To the individual, secret suffering individuals endured in silence. May this be the year of great revival in our passion for God and for His work.

Are you ready to take up His call? Are you ready for revival?

國語堂事工報告

2021 年世界进入了 COVID-19 疫情的第二年。年初,人们怀着忧喜参半的心情迎接即将到来的疫苗,希望民众接种疫苗比例达到某一平衡点,即可回到实体聚会的环境。无奈新型变种病毒势头未减,对人类的攻击波一浪高过一浪。看不见的病毒隔开了你、我、他/她。主内的小组,团契聚会,主日崇拜均安排在网络线上进行。虽然人人被限制在各自家里的空间,仿佛被捆绑一样,然而"神的道却不被捆绑"(提后 2:9)。"这福音本是 神的大能,要救一切相信的"(罗1:16)。圣灵的工作奇妙,圣灵激励国语堂弟兄姊妹们,用诸般的智慧,不懈的努力来拓展神的国度,履行主耶稣给我们的大使命。在 2021 年,我们迎来了春季和圣诞节两次的浸礼,总共有 24 位新葡受浸归入基督,荣耀归主。在岁末年初之际,让我们一同来数算主的恩典,共颂主恩。

神荣耀祂的教会,藉着神的仆人林国辉牧师和袁俊林传道来牧养祂的群羊。统计显示,每主日参加网络线上崇拜的视讯终端登录数*,从1月第一主日为147个,到12月最后主日为140个,全年52周的主日崇拜平均登录数为143个;崇拜人数保持在一个稳定的水平。

神藉着环境栽培我们的属灵生命。外在的环境越是飘渺不定,弟兄姊妹对神的话语越加地渴慕。因为我们的神永不改变:神的话语、应许和荣耀永不改变;神的同在、安慰和引导永不改变。神的话语是我们心里的力量。栽培部的同工们在Q1、Q2及Q4安排6班不同的主日学课程,平均每一季有18位主日学老师;Q3安排了4班主日学课程,連同5位外来讲员,共19位主日学老师。每周的主日学平均参加人数为80人。主日学课程覆盖【福音班】、【初信成长】、【初信栽培班】、【圣经概览班】、【旧约书卷研读】和【新约书卷研读】。有效的主日学安排满足了会众不同学习深度的需要,从认识福音到灵命进深。与主日学相辅相承,刘玉茵老师鼓励国语堂弟兄姊妹每日读经,特别编写了【两年读经】灵修专辑。同工们尽心尽责,每天更新读经日引,每个月安排读经分享聚会。两年下来,共有47位弟兄姊妹完成了【两年读完新旧约圣经】的每日读经计划。

神要藉着网络线上和实体的敬拜,来提高敬拜小组成员们的领诗水准。我们在8月1日恢复了在教会实体的主日领诗敬拜。敬拜团队成员们经常安静在主面前,等待圣灵的恩膏降下,为要预备合宜的敬拜诗歌。在反反复复地排练中,彼此对唱、心被恩感、口唱心和地赞美主。马利亚香膏抹主,把最好的真哪哒香膏献给主耶稣。司琴、亚萨乐队、领诗小组成员们常常彼此鼓励,效法马利亚,把最好的献给主耶稣。亚萨乐队把标杆瞄准那些充满赞美恩膏的敬拜团队,不断努力,带领会众同心赞美敬拜。

"我们在一切患难中,祂就安慰我们,叫我们能用 神所赐的安慰去安慰那遭各样患难的人。"(林后 1:4)。关顾部的同工们藉着电话及网络视迅工具,祷告安慰那些身心灵软弱的人,遇到特殊或有急切需要的情况,就安排上门探访。在短短 3 个多月的实体崇拜中,来了 15 位新朋友,迎新团队的同工就联络跟进。在过去一年里,七位关顾同工们联系关怀了 96 位的弟兄姐妹和福音朋友,联络的总次数有 230 次之多。谢谢关顾部的同工们整理的关顾记录,情文并茂,读着仿佛听到了关顾同工与对方的现场对话。并且,关顾同工们大多身兼数职,在其它服事上也有份;他/她们所作的已超越了他/她们自己预期所能做到的。感谢主的恩典激励他/她们,为主摆上,侍主蒙福。

忠心的总务同工们在 3 个多月的实体崇拜中,担负起现场会众接待和人员登记的责任。在每次实体崇拜过后,一旦有人发现确诊,就预备随时电话通知参与者。12 月 19 日主日圣诞节的浸

礼,为了让 18 位新葡能在安全的环境下顺利接受洗礼,同工们精心安排在教会大堂举行浸礼,又布置好个人更衣室,浸礼完成后随即把有关布置拆卸,并将场地清理好。圣诞节的浸礼于下午2:30 正式开始,4:30 完满结束。感谢弟兄姊妹们的祷告和神的恩典保守,自浸礼当天起两周内,国语堂没收到任何 COVID-19 感染报告。愿一切的感恩和颂赞都归于神!

"祂的量带通遍天下,祂的言语传到地极"(诗篇 19:4)。神啊,祢的作为奇妙!世人虽被疫情捆锁,"神的道却不被捆绑"(提后 2:9)。藉着网络直播,福音传到地极。每周主日的线上崇拜,离不开敬拜部同工、音频/视频制作和 AV 同工们不懈的努力。每周在屏幕的背后,都有众多同工们不辞劳苦的摆上,来协调直播前的准备工作。众多的环节、每周的 PPT 诗歌歌词、教会的消息、录像的片段井然有序地合成并播放;还要面对老旧设备的挑战。求主记念 AV 和敬拜同工们无私的摆上。藉着网络直播和视迅工具,崇拜部带领诗歌敬拜,外展部传福音、布道,超越了时空的限制,国语堂安排的许多线上聚会的主题吸引了本地及外地的慕道朋友来参加。司事团队属于敬拜部的一部分,3个多月实体崇拜得以顺利进行,有赖司事同工们的忠心服事。

外展部今年开展了幸福小组事工,有 15 位弟兄姊妹参加了幸福小组训练;从第一次参与学习到幸福小组传福音的应用, 8 月到 12 月之间有五位新葡信主并受浸。

今年生命小组事工部推动新的事工【男人的天空】,共有四个小组,合计有 24 位弟兄参加。团契和生命小组的同工们一整年都在努力安排组织各项事工,包括敬拜、查经、祷告、聚会、 爱心关顾、步行之类的户外活动,帮助弟兄姊妹和朋友们在疫情中作生命连结。

嘉年团是国语堂年长者的团契,12 月 14 日在教会体育馆进行了自疫情以来首次实体聚会,有 43 人参加。国语堂的两位牧者、荣休了的杨牧师和杨师母均有到场参加。

在疫情肆虐全球这段时间,有很多人丧失了生命,也有很多基督徒失掉了灵魂。 主耶稣已经预先告诉了我们末后的征兆,并藉着十个童女的比喻告诫我们要警醒,作聪明的童女。 "聪明的拿着灯,又预备油在器皿里 (太 24:5)。 "新郎到了,那预备好了的,同他进去坐席,门就关了" (太 25:10)。主耶稣应许我们: "你们常存忍耐,就必保全灵魂 " (路 21:19)。无论未来有如沧海桑田变换,基督徒都当定睛主耶稣,因祂的话语、应许、荣耀、同在、安慰和引导永不改变。

YLD – Grades 7-12 Ministry Report

Pastor Tim Vang and YLD Youth Ministry Team

God has most graciously brought us through another year. We are thankful for His providence **and have great reason to** rejoice. No matter the circumstances or challenges, may the church and believers continue to lift his name high with joyful hearts.

It has been a great privilege and honor to have some parents journey alongside the youth in youth ministry. We have prayer meetings for parents every other Monday: first Monday of the month for Mandarin, and third Monday of the month for Cantonese. This has been helpful to build support among the parents as well as to connect them with youth ministry updates regularly.

In Driven, we finished our final sermon series on The Gospel of John. For the final month and continuing in the coming year, Driven Worship is teaching chronologically from Genesis to Revelation to see the grand narrative of God's redemptive plan. We are especially grateful to our speakers who devote their time to prepare and give the message each Sunday.

As the government opened worship services for churches, our youth pastor, Pastor Tim, and Charlton, Worship Chair of YLD Youth, tried hybrid services, running both online and in-person Sunday worship on October 17. Thanks to the involvement of parents and youth who volunteered willingly in the praise team, the registry table and especially Tom Kang, a parent who had brought his own equipment to better the audio and visual system, they marched forward in the Kingdom work and spread the Good News without hesitation. We had 26 people and 23 counts online: a total of 49 counts in the first day record of attendance. The average count was 37 in the year of 2021.

We very much appreciate all the service the Timotheus Counsellors have poured into preparing every fellowship program. This year Timotheus Fellowship has gone through a series of apologetics lessons, which tackle questions and struggles people may have towards God and Christianity. They've also spent time studying the minor prophets and the Bible patriarchs. In the coming year, Timotheus will be going through "The Rescue" curriculum, which focuses on Christ's mission to redeem His people. The counsellors have volunteered to have prayer meetings on Monday and games nights on Tuesday in addition to the fellowship time on Friday to reach out to youth online. Discussion nights, hosted by Charlton, have also been a valuable asset in reaching out to the youths online.

Koinonia Fellowship has done a great job in nurturing a welcoming atmosphere for the grade 9 newcomers. Many of the newcomers have voiced their enjoyment of the fellowship and programs. The counsellors have challenged and encouraged the youth with various faith topics and lessons, with a particular emphasis on studying the Parables of Jesus and their applications to modern day life. We give a big thanks to the time and devotion the leaders put into making this possible and strengthening the faith of the youth as they prepare for their university years.

When the school term started in September, both Timotheus and Koinonia Fellowship counsellors had the youth meetings in the park. *We* had 29 and 26 for Koinonia and Timotheus respectively. The youth liked to meet with each other to share God's love and their life stories during **the pand**emic. Timotheus had

gym nights at our church every first Friday of the month and Koinonia **started to meet in-person eve**ry Friday evening from mid-October. Thanks to the devoted caring of the **counsellor teams**. **It has been s**uch a blessing to have our Sunday School teachers faithfully prepare lessons each week for the youth. Sunday School has finished "The Life" curriculum and moved on to the "Amplify" curriculum, which touches on topics such as spiritual gifts, **steward**ship, evangelism, God's **character and** much more. The heart and service of the teachers **have been exemplary**.

We can provide 3 to 4 classes for the youth. The **teachers have gotten to** know their students **and have been a**ble to adapt and connect better with them in learning God's Word online. Thanks to the **patience and care of the teachers. We pray that more parents and volunteers c**an help fill teaching ro**les** in the coming year.

God remembers and knows all your service and sacrifice this year. May we all continue **to serve** our best in the coming year. May God's faithfulness in the past be a reminder of His providence for the future. It was an honor and blessing to serve alongside everyone. We wish everyone well in the coming year and we very much love the church of MCBC. God bless.

Letter to YLD Youth Parents

January 29, 2022

Dear Parents of YLD Youth,

Happy Chinese New Year! As we anticipate to welcome the Year of the Tiger, we are likely making plans of what to buy and what to cook to celebrate the New Year with family, loved ones and friends. As parents, we also make plans for our children (child) and go to great lengths to ensure our kids are well taken care of and to excel in their life, health and studies. We simply want the best for them.

The question is what is the best for them? Is it comfort and worldly success? The Bible gives an answer that is totally different. It is found in Romans 8:28: the promise that God works for our good "in all things." It means that no matter the circumstance, there are only two qualifiers for God to be working all things together for our good.

First, He works for "the good of those who love Him." If you love God, you can trust that He is working for your good. Second, He works for "those who are called according to His purpose." Do you realize that following God entails submitting to His purpose for you? Being called according to God's purpose also reminds us of what "our good" actually is. It's the furthering of His Kingdom of Heaven through us. Yes, we want our kids to get good grades, have good health, to succeed in this world and to have a comfortable life. But God has something better for us: it is the free gift of eternal life in heaven with God where all believers of Christ worship God forever.

So, as parents how do we go about achieving the first qualifier, "loving God," in our kids? It starts with meeting and getting to know who God is through reading and studying the Bible, praying to God, worshiping, and meeting with other Christians. In Proverbs 1:7 it says, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge..." where this fear is further described in Proverbs 15:33 as the "discipline" or "instruction" of wisdom. It is a fear that comes forth out of love for the Lord Jesus.

In this day and age, it is not easy to motivate teenagers or sometime even to talk to them. I encourage you to pray for them asking the Holy Spirit to give you the wisdom, patience and love as you guide and teach them. In Proverbs 22:6 it says, "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it." and in Proverbs 29:17, "Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart."

Romans 8:28 does not apply to kids only, it's also applies to all of us. We, as parents, are the greatest example to our kids. It may seem they are not listening to us, but they are watching us all the time. So, are we setting a good example by following the two greatest commandments that Jesus gave us, and found in Mark 12:30 & 31, "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

I hope and pray that this letter will inspire you and your children (child) to get to know Jesus in a personal and intimate way. Jesus is standing at the door and is knocking. Will you open the door and let Jesus into your heart?

If you have any questions about YLD Youth ministry, whether it's Driven worship or Sunday school or Fellowship or even just to pray for you and your family, please do not hesitate to contact any of us that are copied in this letter. With help of the Holy Spirit, we will do our best to assist you.

致青少年家長信

親爱的青少年家長:

農曆新年快樂!在迎接虎年來臨之際,我們都會作各種計劃,例如:買些什麽、做什麽菜式與家人、心愛的人、朋友慶祝新年呢?作為父母,我們也會為我們的孩子定下計劃,竭盡全力確保他們得到週全的照顧,在生活、健康和學習各方面表現出色。我們總是希望給他們最好的。

問題是什麼才是對他們最好?舒適和世俗的成功?聖經給我們不一樣的答案。《羅馬書 8:28》這樣寫:上帝應許為我們的益處"萬事都一同效力"。意思就是無論在任何境況,上帝只按著兩個特定的條件,為我們的益處讓所有事情一同效力。

YLD Children's Ministry Report

Pastor Joanne Lee, Xenia Tang and Katherine Leung

Despite spending the whole year online, God has been gracious to children's ministry this year. We're continuing to develop relationships with the children and their families despite the challenges of being online. We were able to go through an overview of the whole Bible in worship, and we've got a fairly consistent turnout for both Lil Light of Mine (0-SK fellowship) and Kidmin Hour (Gr. 1-6 fellowship). We were able to do some special events throughout the year and those helped us to grow together as a ministry as well. In 2021, some of our Children's Ministry Core Team members stepped down to serve in other capacities. We are thankful for their time with us and we pray for them in their new ministries. Throughout the year, we hired 9 interns through the Canada Summer Jobs grant and we're thankful for their support in ministry as well.

Worship

This year, we went through a long series based on Phil Vischer's, "What's in the Bible?" series. It's an overview of the Bible talking about how although the Bible has many smaller stories in it, it is still one big story talking about God's salvation plan for mankind. This series took us to the end of November, when we started our Advent series. This year for Advent, we focused on the theme of Advent meaning, "to come". This summer, we also did a special series on world missions and learned about some of the missionaries that MCBC supports. Each first week of the month, we also do a special message we call a God Story. A God Story is a moment or moments in your life where you saw God at work. It's part of your testimony. By sharing our God stories, we get to know more about the power of God made real in each of our lives in different ways, because everyone's stories are unique! Every 5th Sunday of the month, we also joined with YLD Youth and the English Division to bring back Generation Worship, where everyone, no matter how old, worshipped together. We will be putting Generation on hiatus for the time being though, as we figure out how to make it work in light of the whole hybrid situation.

Kidmin Hour

Kidmin Hour ran for three terms in 2021. We took a break for the summer and ran a book club for the older kids. We changed Kidmin Hour from Saturdays only to Saturdays and Sundays, so there would be more flexibility in scheduling for the children. We had about 35 children join us for Kidmin Hour this term. Most of our volunteers this year were youths and young adults. We're thankful for all our volunteers and we hope we'll have more join us! We started a new segment of Kidmin Hour called Operation World, after the resource with the same name. Each session, we learn about a new country and how we can pray for that country, and we encourage the children to pray alongside us. We've now prayed through North America and are about halfway through Central and South America.

Lil Light of Mine

In 2021 we kicked off our Lil Light of Mine program as toddlers and kinder kids and their families began gathering online for a time of fellowship and fun! We journeyed through the different Fruit of the Spirit through songs, mini activities and games. This past fall we learned about prayer and practiced it through our Fall Into Prayer series. Each week, we learned about a fun, new way moms and dads can journey with their lil' lights in prayer. We were also able to spend some time with our Lil Light families in person during the summer and fall during our Balloon Meet and Greet, where Pastor Joanne and Xenia twisted balloons for the families who came by, and during our Fall Prayer Walk, where the Lil Light families took a walk through our church neighborhood and prayed for those in our community. We look forward to more fellowship and fun to come!

Summer+

This year, we did 6 weeks of online camp and had about 70 children join us. Our theme this year was stories in the Bible that had animals in them. Most of our children were from MCBC, but we also had a number of children from other churches join us, as well as a number of non-church families join us as well. Some of our children accepted Jesus as their Lord and Saviour during camp. Please keep them in your prayers.

Scouts

This year, Scouts had a total of 60 participants. From January to June, Scouts met online via Zoom, and from September to December, Scouts was able to meet in person. From time to time, spiritual messages were shared by Pastor Joanne, Xenia, Ben, and Collin. Scouts was also able to have a group hiking event in September.

Choir

In 2021, regular Online Rehearsals of Children and Youth Choir had been done on Sunday afternoons. Since the Pandemic started in 2020, each Saturday our young singers had a chance to take turn to attend a 30 minutes one-on-one Vocal Lessons, which helped them improved a lot on their singing.

Our Handbell Choir continued to have Online Rehearsals for the whole 2020/2021 Season until June 2021. We decided to resume Handbell Rehearsals when we could have In-person Rehearsals at MCBC.

In 2021, Children & Youth Choir had Virtual Choir presentations at English, Mandarin and Cantonese Sunday Services on Chinese New Year, Mother's Day and Father's Day. We also had our Annual Recital in June although an online one. Our Choir members also presented at the MCBC Cantonese Christmas Eve Program. Both Children & Youth Choir and Handbell Choir joined 2021 STM Easter Evangelism Outreach Program on Good Friday. Children & Youth Choir presented 2 songs, "Listen to the Words that God Has Spoken" and "Grant Us Peace" at the GTA Cantonese Revival Meeting in November.

2021 was a challenging year especially under the pandemic. We are thankful with God's guidance and blessing that we could still work together and lead our young singers and ringers to continue the service to God.

Special Events

Training – From January to March, we held a children's ministry leadership training term, which ran Jan-Mar. We had just under 20 leaders join us for this training, and it was a wonderful time of learning, challenging each other, strengthening each other, and building community. We've also streamlined our training process for online children's ministry.

Operation Christmas Child Packing Party – We had a church-wide packing party on Oct 30. We invited the entire church to an outdoor, social-distanced packing party where everyone brought their gifts and we provided them with the boxes and everything else they'd need to pack their boxes. We had a number of families join us, but not many from the rest of the church. We hope that in the future, more of the church will join us as we give joyfully in this way. We did surpass the number of packed boxes we gave last year though. This year, we packed 165 boxes!

Fall Fest – This year for Fall Fest, we did a family baking party. We had about 45 families join us to make apple crisp. Most of these families gathered with us virtually and we had a wonderful time baking together from our own homes. The apple crisps were tasty too. =)

Into 2022

We spent a lot of time last year diving into the Old Testament, so at least early in 2022, we'll be looking into the life of Jesus. We'll continue to run Kidmin Hour and Lil Light and we'll continue to prepare for church re-entry, including working on updating our protection policy. We're watching as our children learn and grow and we look forward to continue to walk alongside them and their families in this coming year.

New Media Ministry Report

We are still doing many of our ministries online, so this year, a big focus of ours was to figure out how to best use Youtube. We now have separate Youtube channels for all three language divisions, particularly because we needed to livestream different services at the same time, and any Youtube channel may only host one livestream at a time. Cantonese Division has many media productions beyond worship services, but English and Mandarin primarily focus on their worship services.

New Media Ministry also did some other projects, like partnering with the Community Concerns Committee to create promotion videos for their events, work on updating the missions webpage, and work on revamping the children's ministry webpages. The groundwork for this last one has been completed, but the details are still in the works.

社區關懷委員會報告

伍志偉執事

在新冠疫情肆虐下,社會民生受到極大影響。特別是對一班邊緣人士,街頭露宿者,低收入的勞苦大眾。他們所面對的問題不單止是基本生活的需要,甚至孩子在家中的學習都要面對很大的衝擊。根據大多市的報告,居民對食物銀行的需求大幅增加。這種情況有明顯上升的跡象。市民居住在環境陝窄的地方去面對抗疫,社交距離,家中隔離等會加增家庭成員不健康心理的情緒及家庭暴力的問題。現今,社會學專家仍不能評估疫情所帶來長遠的負面影響。

教會使命是要去關顧弱勢社群,被遺棄及有需要的鄰舍。用實際行動將神的愛透過物資及金錢帶到 社區中。教會議會於去年二月成立社區關懷小組及通過五萬元預算去回應社會的需要。小組主要工 作是尋覓合適本地宣教的夥伴讓弟兄姊妹能夠認識,支持並參與他們的工作。這些本地宣教機構都 是服務一些低下基層的家庭,兒童及露宿者。最終目標是可以帶領他們認識並接受主耶穌。小組亦 同時支持一些教會以外非牟利的機構例如食物銀行等。

以下是一些活動的簡報:

- 1. 募捐食物:7月10-11日下午在教會停車場收集弟兄姊妹捐贈的食物。總共收到15車箱的食物並於翌日全數送到烈治文山食物銀行。
- 2. 步行籌款:10 月2日及16日五公里步行在Newmarket Nokiidea Trail 舉行。雖然第二次步行活動因天氣緣故要需要延期一星期,當日天氣亦有毛毛細雨但不減卻弟兄姊妹的熱誠。二次步行有超過160人參加。一家大小享受一次戶外活動又可以同弟兄姊妹相見並籌得\$18,000資助本地宣教夥伴,Urban Promise.
- 3. 寒衣送暖流。11 月7 日教會幫二間本宣教機構收集寒衣。弟兄姊妹反應熱烈,將家中一些 全新或近乎新的寒衣帶到教會。總共收到 110 袋寒衣,全部送到有需要的機構。

感謝神讓教會同工及領袖願意對鄰舍有負擔,走出教會的牆進入社區。更感謝神讓弟兄姊妹積極踴躍參與不同的社區關懷活動,付出時間,金錢,物資去回應呼籲。特別多謝新媒體事工在繁忙之中 為小組製作不同宣傳的短片鼓勵弟兄姊妹的參與。

Community Concern Committee Report

Under the raging of the new coronavirus pandemic, societies and people's livelihood have been greatly affected, especially the marginalized people, the homeless and the low-income working people. The difficulties they are facing are not only the basic needs of daily life, but also the hardship they are encountering for their children's learning at home. According to the Metropolitan City report, residents' demand for food banks has increased significantly. There are clear signs showing this rising trend. There are great impacts on people living in a small area while fighting against the pandemic, maintaining social distancing and doing self-isolating at home. Family members' mental and emotional health is greatly affected; domestic violence also tends to increase. Today, sociology experts are still unable to assess the long-term negative impact of the epidemic.

The mission of the church is to care for the disprivileged, the abandoned and the needy, to bring God's love to the community in action by providing them with materials and financial support. The church council established a community care committee in February in 2021, approved a budget of CAD50,000 to respond to the needs of the community. The main work of the committee is to identify suitable local missionary partners, to provide opportunity for brothers and sisters to understand, support and participate in their work. These local missionary agencies are serving low-income families, children and homeless people. Their ultimate goal is to lead them to know and accept the Lord Jesus. The group also supports non-profit organizations outside the church, such as the Food Bank.

Below is a summary of the committee's activities:-

1. Food donation - July 10 & 11

Food donations were collected from brothers and sisters at the church's parking lot. A total of 15 boxes of food collected were dropped off at the Richmond Hill Food Bank on the following day.

2. Walkathon - October 2 & 16, a 5km walk along the Newmarket Nokiidea Trail

Despite that the second day was postponed by a week due to unfavorable weather, and it was drizzling on the event day, it did not reduce brothers' and sisters' enthusiasm. A total of 160 people participated. Families enjoyed a family outdoor activity, and at the same time brothers and sisters got the chance to meet each other. CAD18,000 was collected to support our local missionary partner Urban Promise.

3. Winter clothing donation – November 7

We collected clothing for two local missionary organizations. Brothers and sisters responded enthusiastically, they brought some new or barely used clothing to the church. A total of 110 bags of winter clothing were collected, all of which were delivered to the organizations which have a need for them.

Thank God for uniting church staff and leaders in setting up the Community Concern Committee, bringing the church out of the church building and walk into the community, to care for our neighborhood. I also thank God for touching brothers' and sisters' hearts, driving them to participate actively in various

community concern activities; they spend time, donate money and materials to respond to the appeal. Special thanks go to the New Media Ministry which, among their tight working schedule, produced different promotional videos to help encouraging brothers and sisters to participate.

COVID-19, Pandemic, Delta, Omicron, Lockdown...

These are the words we heard frequently in the year of 2021. Undeniably, for most of us, the pandemic has brought about dramatic changes to our way of life. We miss those wonderful times when we can physically worship together with brothers and sisters at church, chat with our colleagues in the office hallway, play basketball with our buddies at the gym, and go to dim sum with family at a restaurant.

The impact of the pandemic is certainly not only happening locally, but all around the world. Among our 25 supporting missionaries, some of them were held up in Canada for an extended period before they could return to the field where they consider those places to be their homes. This brought about challenges to their ministries, as well as added financial stress on themselves, their families, and their supporting organizations.

As a serving partner of these missionaries and mission organizations, MCBC Mission Board has strived to provide our committed and additional financial support at such a critical time of need. Our Short-term Mission (STM) Ministry has been put on a pause indefinitely due to COVID-19. However, big challenges bring new opportunities. We pray that we can continue to effectively use new approaches to maintain the relationships and prepare new STM teams to serve the fields in the coming years.

Most of our recently supported seminary students have graduated and entered their respective vocation in response to God's calling. In 2022, one student is approaching her final year of study. We are keeping our doors open for more seminary students in the MCBC congregation who aspire to pursue fulltime seminary studies.

We are very happy that two new members have joined the Mission Board team to serve in the coming years. As we turn our attention to 2022, the full and refreshed Mission Board team is excited to use this unique time in history to continue our mission. The harvest is plentiful, but laborers are few. MCBC will continue to support missionaries, mission organizations, seminary students, and mobilize MCBC resources for missions. To help our congregation be more engaged in missions, we are also planning to strengthen our missionary care network among all divisions by collaborating with small groups. When we begin to have a deeper understanding of God's work and movement/plan/purpose around the world in missions, we can grow spiritually too.

While many things remain uncertain about the coming year, we trust that our Lord is on the throne and that He is lovingly pursuing every tribe, language, people, and nation. The Mission team is ready for 2022! Will you prayerfully consider how you might partner with us?


