The most challenging part of our furlough is traveling to five cities with two toddlers. We can't imagine how we could have gone through the four months without the help from family, friends, and church brothers and sisters. A great thanks to friends and family who helped babysit our kids during our workdays. Also, a great appreciation to those who lent us their car, their house and even children's toys

and clothes. And of course, thank you for all the warm hospitality, the fun gatherings and the great food. We have been filled with not only the delicious food, but also with all the love and joy.

#### From West to East

During the four months of furlough, we traveled to 5 cities. First, we returned to west coast of USA, the San Francisco Bay Area. Then we flew to the middle of the Pacific ocean – Hawaii, to the first church that Sarah attended and came to know Christ. Later,

Kenny went to the Midwest of USA, Columbus, Ohio, then to the East coast, New York. For Kenny who is from Canada, he caught a great glimpse of what the USA is like.

Sarah was very excited to have a chance to meet with mission committee members from our many supporting churches. Before, we can only communicate through email or whatapps. Now we finally had a chance to meet in person, so we can show our appreciation in person for their continued pray and support.

We praise Lord for given us opportunities to share our ministries in Colombia for the past four years. Every time, when we share our stories, we have been reminded of God's wonderful blessing and provision. We thank our Lord for not only giving us opportunities to share our ministries, but to also have some meetings with churches for short term mission planning. Many churches have expressed their wish to send short-term mission teams to Colombia in the near future. It has been a great encouragement to us. Please continue pray for this. May Lord give us the vision for planning, so we know better how to work with church from North America to better serve the mission field.

# Looking forward to our serving

It's been two months since we returned to the mission field. Sarah and Kenny have spent a great amount of time reorganizing our ministries as well as our home. Praise the Lord for looking after us. Now everything is back on track. Isaias and Imanuel have adapted their life in mission field pretty well. Isaias started to pick up his Spanish again.

#### Chinese class and mom's group

The Chinese class stopped for four months due to our furlough. Sarah was worried that the students would forget what they had learned. Surprisingly, everyone did very well on the first test after we resumed our Chinese class. For the mom's group, their friendship has been stronger and stronger. We have to give credit to for all the missionaries and short term mission teams who followed up with the mom's group when we were away for furlough.

Now every Friday, Sarah teaches Chinese class to the children and youth. Kenny teaches Bible lessons and

Christian belief to the mom's group. Sometimes, we have local Colombia church sisters to help us, sharing Bible stories with the kids. We are hoping that we can invite more

brothers and sisters from local church to help us. So the kids can learn better about Christ.

#### Expanding our visitation

Visitation is still playing a very important role in our ministry. Perhaps Sarah & Kenny's Spanish has been improved a little bit, God has been expanding our horizons. Before our furlough, we mainly focused on visiting the Chinese in Bogota. Now, even though we still focus on serving the Chinese, God has opened opportunity for us to share gospel with the local Colombian.

One day, Kenny visited the Chinese restaurant as usual, the owner invited him to go to his living area which is on the second floor of the restaurant. While passing through a dark and humid room, Kenny heard some crying baby sounds. Indeed inside this room, there was a woman peeling potatoes and next to her was a baby, sitting in an old and torn stroller. Kenny found out from this woman that the baby girl has spinal and respiratory tract problems, which affect her development, both physically and mentally. The restaurant hires both the mother and father of the baby girl, hoping to help them solve some financial issues. However, there are still many difficulties for this family: daily living issues, medical bills, etc. The following week, we came back with another Colombian church sister. She was able to share the gospel with this woman and eventually, the woman accepted Christ as her personal savior. Even though we may not help this family solve all their problems completely, we hope after they learn the Good News, they may find hope in Christ. Just as our Colombian church brothers and sisters share with us, many of them are from broken family, and with very few things. After they came to know Christ, their life has changed completely. In Christ, they found a home with brothers and sisters who help out each other. Even though they still don't own much, they feel satisfied spiritually.

May our Lord continue to guide us. May we continue to improve our Spanish language skills, so we can better work with the local church brothers and sisters.

現在每個星期五上課聚會, 慧琳負責教中文, 雋禧跟媽媽組學習聖經及基督教信仰。偶爾也 有本地姊妹幫忙說聖經故事, 分享信仰。期待 以後可以邀請更多本地弟兄姐妹幫忙, 和小朋 友們有更多的機會分享福音、敬拜主。

#### 擴展探訪族群

在工場服事,探訪依然是我們非常重要的工作。 或許是因為慧琳和雋禧的西文進步了點,上帝 更加擴展了我們的眼界。以往探訪,主要對象 是這裡的華人朋友,但這次回到工場後,雖然

還是以華人為主,但也看到上帝開始給我們機會接觸華人餐館中的哥倫比亞人。

有一次,雋禧一如以往到華人餐館探訪店主,獲邀到樓上店主居住的地方坐坐。經 過一個又暗又潮濕的房間,雋禧聽到嬰兒的哭聲,原來是一位哥倫比亞員工在那裏 刨馬鈴薯,旁邊有一台破舊的嬰兒車,裡面躺著的嬰孩正在哇哇地哭著。基於同是 為人父母的心情,雋禧跟這位員工聊了一下。原來這員工有五個孩子,躺在嬰兒車 內的娃娃雖然已經差不多三歲,卻因為脊髓、呼吸都有問題,影響了她的發育。店 主聘請他們夫婦二人,希望可以幫助他們解決生活所需。可是好像如何努力工作, 家裡依然有一大堆的問題,生活的,醫療的,壓到喘不過氣。後來,我們帶同一位 哥倫比亞基督徒姊妹,一起探訪這家庭。姊妹跟他們分享福音,最後,這位媽媽接 受了耶穌。這或許是一個很平凡的故事,但我們希望當這個家庭認識了耶穌,可以 從耶穌裡找到盼望,找到前路的光。正如不少的哥倫比亞弟兄姐妹跟我們說,雖然 他們擁有的物質很少,有些甚至是來自破碎家庭,但當他們認識耶穌後,耶穌給了 他們朋友,生活的供應,在教會找到了家的感覺。雖然物質依然不多,卻在屬靈裡 有滿足,有盼望。這是何等的寶貴,對我們也是很大的提醒。

求主帶領慧琳和雋禧,加深我們的語言能力,以便可以和當地的哥倫比亞弟兄姐妹一起配合,將福音帶給更多的群體。

#### Serving with ICCC brothers and sisters

February, we had a short-term team of more than 20 brothers and sisters from Panama. Sarah was on her last stage of pregnancy and couldn't lead the team. Thus we were short of leaders for the short-term mission team. We thank the Lord for raising ICCC brothers and sisters to step up to be team leaders. At the last count, we had 7 team leaders from ICCC, hosting the short-term mission team as they did visitation. It was a wonderful experience that ICCC brothers and sisters had a chance to share the Gospel with the local Chinese. Sarah & Kenny are very excited to see members of our church grow up spiritually. In the future, may we have more opportunities like this, as we go with church brothers and sisters, to visit the local Chinese restaurants and stores.







#### Serving with our family

It has been almost three years since we started serving in the Colombia mission field. We thank the Lord for His guidance as we have developed friendships between the Chinese and even the locals. But lately we discovered that it is our children, Isaias and Imanuel who are the most popular! Every time we do visitation with them, they bring joy and happiness to the restaurants and stores. When people come to our church, the first thing they ask is "Where are Isaias and Imanuel?" And some of them even come to church with their children because they want to play with our two sons. In our Bible study group, we always ask Isaias to hang out with the kids, so parents can focus on the Bible study. And we believe in the near future, Imanuel can join this mission team too.

During Sarah's first month of postpartum, Kenny's dad came to help take care of Isaias. He was not only able to help take care of the kids, he also went to visit the Chinese with Kenny and shared the Gospel. We praise Lord for giving our family, all three generations, the opportunity to serve Him together.









#### **Expanding the mission field**

Ever since beginning our service in Bogota three years ago, Sarah & Kenny have always been thinking about expanding our mission field beyond Bogota, the capitol. Now, as our two children grow a little older, we have more flexibility to go out and visit other areas. In the past two months, we visited some nearby cities. Unlike the capitol, there aren't many Chinese restaurants and shops in these cities, so few Chinese Christians have visited these areas before. Thus, the Jehovah Witness have been able to dominate the area.

Our initial plan is through visitation, we will distribute Gospel tracts, newspapers and magazines and build up friendship with the Chinese people in these cities. We pray that God will provide more opportunities for us to share the Gospel with them and even host Gospel gatherings in these cities.







We praise the Lord for His guidance in our marriage. We celebrated our third anniversary in Mid August and also we are about to finish our first term in the mission field. Looking back the past few years, we have experienced God's grace in great abundance. We encountered difficulties and challenges, and sometime we even felt like there is no way out, but looking back, we learned all these are ways that God trains us to grow up and be more mature spiritually. May we willingly surrender what we have and be molded by our Lord. Thus we can be a good witness to our Lord and a vessel for God's honor.

In mid Aug, there was a house fire in Bogota, which claimed the life of a Chinese woman and her two children Please pray for the husband.

We have short-term mission teams in September, November and Christmas. May Lord use these teams to bless the Chinese and the rocus in Colombia.

Please also pray for the short-term mission team members. May Lord prepare their heart to serve in Colombia.

We will return to Canada and USA for furlough from January to April 2018. May our Lord provide us the suitable help for the Colombia mission field while we are away. Also, please pray for our time in Canada and USA. We are looking for opportunities to share our ministry, especially for our supporting churches. We are looking forward to meeting with brothers and sisters, so we can show our appreciation for their support in person.
