#### 2. Updates on Church Physical Gathering Reopening

Thanks to the Lord! After months of collaborative efforts in combating the pandemic, we finally see it mitigating. After several consultations and discussions, the Physical Gathering Reopening Committee has decided the following reopening plan:

<u>Cantonese Service</u>: resume in-person Noon Service (11:15 AM), with live streaming, on Aug. 15th; Morning Service (8 AM) and Sunday School remain online

<u>Mandarin Service</u>: continue to run via live streaming; date to resume in-person service to be confirmed.

English Service: continue to be run online; date to resume in-person service to be confirmed.

The arrangement and logistics of the resumed service have been adapted to comply with the following government guidelines:

- Pre-registration is required: <u>http://intl.mcbc.com/apps/registration</u> (participants are recommended to be fully vaccinated)
- 2-metre physical distancing among participants
- Wearing of face masks is required
- No after-service gathering will be arranged
