



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Happy Chinese New Year to all of you! It has been a while since we last updated you. Hope you all had a wonderful time with family and friends just like we did. Thank you for those who attended our Commissioning Ceremony earlier this year; it was very heartwarming to have everyone share this meaningful moment with us.



We haven't met 100% of our fundraise budget yet, but GOI, our mission agency, still allowed us to come down by faith, we are now safely back to Panama. This departure felt harder than before, because we know that we won't be able to see our family and friends for a longer period of time.

Jacky and Emilia's eczema has been flaring up lately. It could most likely be weather related. It is currently the "summer" season in Panama, which is very hot and dry with little wind at night. This weather will persist until April when it starts to slowly rain again.

On the ministry side, Jacky already had work assigned for the next 3 months prior to our departure, so he started work right after we arrived and preached at our church's Chinese congregation the week we arrived. He also needs to start Spanish classes soon again and is planning to enrol into a formal Spanish course or University course. Although he can serve in the Chinese congregation, there's still a lot of help needed in the Spanish congregation.



We also just came back from the annual Chinese-Spanish Youth Summer Camp aka “Campamento Juvenil” (February 4-9). This year’s theme was “Created for Eternity - Ecclesiastes 3:11” and was held at a campsite 2 hours away from the city. I had the opportunity to serve as a Group Leader and Jacky as a Helper in 2 different groups. It was my first time serving at a camp and it was a great experience being able to serve the Lord in different aspects. It was again a very successful camp but sadly, there was no Chinese group this year. Please pray for more participants next camp, which will be the English Camp in June.
